

HALF DAY TOUR TO MUSEUM OF PEASANTS UPRISING AND MONUMENT OF MATIJA GUBEC

Matija Gubec monument

On a hillside, overlooking the Stubica valley, stands a 6.5 m high statue of Matija Gubec, leader of Peasant Uprising, with two symmetrical wings rising behind it decorated with bronze reliefs portraying over three hundred characters. The author of the monument is Antun Augustinčić and it was completed for the 4th centenary of the Peasants' Revolt, on the opening day of the Peasants' Revolt Museum in 1973.



Museum

The museum was founded and opened to the public on the 400th anniversary of the great 1573 Peasants' Revolt. It is situated in the 18th century baroque palace of the Oršić family and was built at the site of a medieval fort
